KEY POINTS

- The course explains the process of writing a guideline protocol, covers the basics of GRADE, and describes necessary actions after completing a guideline.
- The course includes PPT slides and video presentations with a combined duration of approximately 30 minutes, and takes an estimated 45 minutes to complete including final assessment.
- Target audience includes gastroenterologists in training, physicians in other disciplines, surgeons, nurses, biotechnicians, and advanced-years medical students interested in guideline development.
