KEY POINTS

- Upper gastrointestinal bleeding is a common emergency associated with substantial mortality and requires multidisciplinary management involving intensivists, gastroenterologists, haematologists and surgeons.
- The course covers general management principles, endoscopic management of bleeding sites, and strategies for cases where endoscopic therapy fails.
- The target audience includes gastroenterologists, physicians and surgeons in other disciplines, nursing staff, endoscopy associates and medical students who care for patients with potential upper GI bleeding.

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
