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This educational course covers enteral nutrition as the first-choice nutritional support for malnourished patients with functional gastrointestinal tracts, emphasizing its clinical applications and benefits including reduced hospital stay, fewer complications, and improved quality of life.

KEY POINTS

- Enteral nutrition is described as the most physiological type of artificial feeding and should be the first choice for malnourished patients when the gastrointestinal tract is functional.
- Enteral nutrition can decrease length of hospital stay and rate of complications while positively impacting quality of life.
- The course includes PPT slides and video presentations filmed in Zagreb in September 2021, with an estimated completion time of 60 minutes including assessment.
- The target audience includes gastroenterologists in training, nutrition nurses, dietitians, intensivists, medical students, and other healthcare professionals caring for patients receiving enteral nutrition.
