KEY POINTS

- Oesophageal adenocarcinoma is associated with a high mortality rate and Barrett oesophagus is its most important risk factor, with incidence of both conditions increasing globally
- Patients with Barrett oesophagus undergo regular endoscopic surveillance to detect cancer at an early and curable stage
- Endoscopic treatment possibilities for Barrett related neoplasia have enhanced significantly in recent years and this therapy has proven to be highly effective
