Polish Pancreatic Club Working Group presents consensus recommendations for the management of pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma, covering diagnosis, surgical, adjuvant, and palliative treatment.

KEY POINTS

- The recommendations address management of pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma, a neoplasia characterised by an aggressive course and extremely poor prognosis.
- Recommendations cover diagnosis, surgical treatment, adjuvant treatment, and palliative treatment, with consideration of endoscopic and surgical methods.
- The statements are based on data from clinical studies and experts' recommendations from IAP/EPC, ASCO, ESMO, NCCN, PSG, and NICE guidelines.
- All recommendations were voted on by members of the Working Group of the Polish Pancreatic Club, with voting results and brief comments provided for each recommendation.
