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An online educational course on perianal Crohn's disease covers definition, epidemiology, diagnosis, assessment, and medical and surgical treatment options in approximately 50 minutes of video content.

KEY POINTS

- Perianal Crohn's disease is a perianal complication of Crohn's disease consisting of inflammation near the anus in the form of skin tags, fistulas, abscesses and fissures, affecting almost one in four Crohn's patients.
- The course addresses multidisciplinary assessment and treatment, dividing diagnosis and assessment into symptoms, clinical assessment and examination under anaesthesia.
- Treatment options range from initial medical to surgical management.
- The course includes PPT slides and video presentations by Peter Irving and Amy Lightner filmed in London and the United States in 2022, with an estimated completion time of 60 minutes including assessment.
- The target audience includes gastroenterologists in training, physicians and surgeons in other disciplines, and IBD clinical nurse specialists.

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
