This two-part online Advanced ERCP course covers advanced endoscopic techniques including difficult cannulation, biliary stones, cholangioscopy, stricture management, proximal obstruction, bile leaks, pancreatic endotherapy, and EUS-guided access over approximately 120 minutes of video presentations.

KEY POINTS

- The first part covers basic ERCP review, difficult cannulation, difficult biliary stones, cholangioscopy, and biliary stricture evaluation and management
- The second part addresses proximal obstruction, bile leaks, pancreatic endotherapy, EUS-guided access, and aberrant anatomy
- The course includes PPT slides and video presentations by Gavin Johnson, George Webster, and Simon Phillpotts filmed in London in 2022
- Total course duration is approximately 120 minutes with an estimated 2 hours needed to complete including final assessment
- The target audience includes gastroenterologists in training, those in advanced endoscopy or HPB surgery training in ERCP, endoscopy nurses, and medical students interested in gastroenterology

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
