A two-part online Advanced ERCP course covers difficult cannulation, biliary stones, cholangioscopy, strictures, proximal obstruction, bile leaks, pancreatic endotherapy, EUS-guided access, and aberrant anatomy for gastroenterologists and trainees.

KEY POINTS

- The module consists of eight sections total across two parts, with part one covering basic ERCP review, difficult cannulation, difficult biliary stones, cholangioscopy, and biliary stricture evaluation and management
- Part two addresses proximal obstruction, bile leaks, pancreatic endotherapy, EUS-guided access, and aberrant anatomy
- The combined material includes comprehensive slides and video presentations by Gavin Johnson, George Webster, and Simon Phillpotts filmed in London in 2022, with approximately 120 minutes total duration
- The course is designed for gastroenterologists in training, those in advanced endoscopy or HPB surgery training in ERCP, endoscopy nurses, and medical students interested in gastroenterology

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
