This educational session on extraintestinal manifestations in inflammatory bowel disease emphasized that managing these patients requires a multidisciplinary team approach involving multiple specialists.

KEY POINTS

- The speaker stated that treating IBD patients with extraintestinal manifestations necessitates close collaboration between the treating physician, dermatologist, rheumatologists, ophthalmologists, and study nurses.
- The session covered the epidemiology of extraintestinal manifestations in IBD, clinical manifestations including thromboembolic events and therapy side effects, and dual therapies as an emerging approach.
- The speaker explicitly answered that it is necessary to involve specialists when managing extraintestinal manifestations in IBD patients.

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
